

Lighting the Festival Light

The Meaning and Significance of The Season: ROSH HASHANAH, DAYS OF AWE, YOM KIPPUR

V'ahavta

V'ahavta et Adonai elohekha b'kol l'vavcha oovkhol nafsh'kha, oovkhol me'oodekha.
V'hayoo hadvareem ha'ayleh, 'asher 'anokhee m'tsavkha hayom al l'vavekha

And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and all your soul and with all your might. You should bind them as a sign upon your hand and to be as frontlets between your eyes. And you shall write them on the doorpost of your house and on your gates.

K'doosha – Sanctification Prayer

READER: We will sanctify Your name in this world even as it is sanctified in the heavens above, as it is written by Your prophet; and they call to each other saying:

READER: Those facing them say: "Blessed."

CONGREGATION: Blessed is the glory of the Lord from His [abiding] place.

ALL: From your heavenly abode you will appear O our King, and reign over us for we wait for You. When will you reign in Zion? Soon, even in our days, may You dwell there forever and ever. May you be exalted and sanctified within.

Jerusalem your city, from generation to generation and for eternity. May our eyes see Your Kingdom, as it is expressed in the songs of Your Might, by the hand of David, Your righteous Anointed:

The Lord shall reign forever, Your God O Zion, from generation to generation Hallelujah.

Torah Service (Psalm 1:1-3)

(On Your Own at Running Water)

The verses "Who is a G-d like You . . . from the days of yore" allude to the Thirteen Divine Attributes of Mercy. While saying these verses, keep in mind (but do not articulate) the corresponding attribute printed above it in small type. The same is true with the verses "From out of distress . . . trust in nobles," which correspond to the nine attributes in the verse "The L-rd is slow..."
